# Mission



The mission of the Westchester County Youth Bureau is to develop and implement youth initiatives that support the appropriate development and growth of all persons in Westchester County under 21 years of age while paying particular attention to the needs of those most at risk.

# Services Provided

The Youth Bureau provides services that assist youth in:

- Finding employment
- Obtaining career counseling
- College preparedness
- Providing access to STEM experiences and encouraging academic challenges
- Providing student advocacy assistance
- Using out of school time effectively and creatively
- Encouraging school attendance

# Funding



- **Funding for youth programs remains unchanged from 2015**
- **County Tax Levy**
  - Invest in Kids, 43 programs – 3 year cycle – \$1,811,077
  - Miscellaneous Fund – \$206,000
- **New York State Office of Child and Family Services**
  - Positive Youth Development – \$824,566
  - Runaway and Homeless Youth – \$97,942
