**IDENTITY THEFT**

Legislator Abinanti presented two pieces of legislation with regard to identity theft. The first is a local law to protect employees from the impacts of identity theft resulting from the actions of their employees. The second piece of legislation is a local law that would restrict the use of Social Security numbers.

The Committee asked the County Attorney's Office to review the two pieces of legislation and offer suggestions on the direction of each piece of legislation.

The Committee also asked the Administration to give an update on the effects of the County Executive's Executive Order regarding identity theft.
