Dr. Joshua Lipsman, Commissioner of the Department of Health, introduced Deputy Commissioner Renee Recchia who provided a presentation on the Fit Kids Body Mass Index Screening Project. A copy of the presentation is on file and available for review.

He continued to say that there are many factors that may contribute to this, from students having to study more, watching more television, playing video games, and physical education programs being cancelled in schools.
