With a quorum present, the Committee on Legislation was called to order at 1:33 p.m.

**PORTABLE/INFLATABLE SWIMMING POOL ADVISORY**

(Young, Bronz) move the local law that requires the posting of an advisory at retail establishments selling portable/inflatable pools. Motion passed 6-0.

**REQUIRE THE WEARING OF BICYCLE HELMETS**

(Myers, Jenkins) move for a public hearing a local law requiring people fourteen years of age and older operating or riding as a passenger to wear a protective helmet.

The committee asked to change the legislation to consistently read, "operate or riding as a passenger"

Motion passed as amended, 6-0.

**HYBRID PARKING FEE WAIVER**

(Rogowsky, Abinanti) move for all purposes a local law in relation to the parking of certain Hybrid and other fuel efficient vehicles upon County owned property utilized for the purpose of commuter parking. Motion passed 5-0.

Legislator Rogowsky stated that the term hybrid would still be used, but the law would reflect a change to state that all electric, hybrid-electric, or any other motor vehicle that meets the United States Environmental Protection Agency City fuel economy rating of 35 miles per gallon or more will be included.

In two or three years the law will sunset again.

(Abinanti, Myers) Move to adjourn the Committee on Legislation. Motion passed 6-0
