<u>Item(s) Discussed</u>: Refuse Disposal District No. 1

Chair Abinanti welcomed the County Administration and guests to discussion on the proposed municipal agreements and arrangements for solid waste disposal for the municipalities in county Refuse Disposal District No. 1 (RDD#1). Chair Abinanti provided an overview on the existing agreement and various arrangements between the parties for disposal of RDD#1 municipal solid waste (MSW), including the creation of the Charles Point Resource Recovery Facility. Mr. Neuman then described the process of requesting and reviewing the proposals for disposing MSW from RDD#1, as well as the
